Consolidated Baptist Church Scholarship Program

Consolidated Baptist Church Scholarship Awards Program (CBCSAP) was initiated to encourage members of the church who are college-bound or vocational school students to pursue their goals of an education beyond high school. Our belief that “every child can and will learn with the proper educational resources” is echoed by our commitment to provide financial assistance through three distinct scholarships.

Barbara Moody Excellence Through Education Scholarship

Barbara S. Moody was an educator in Lexington, Kentucky. Born in 1916, Ms. Moody attended public schools in Harrodsburg, and went on to receive her degree in Elementary Education from Kentucky State University. Upon moving to Lexington, Ms. Moody became a member of Consolidated Baptist Church, serving as the church musician for many years. She was a tireless worker in our church and in other community organizations. Mrs. Moody believed in helping others realize their dreams. A few years shy of 100 years old, Mrs. Moody passed December 12, 2010.

The Barbara Moody Excellence Through Education Scholarship:

- **\$1000 annually: Awarded in two installments (\$500 fall and spring semesters for a maximum of 4 years)**
- **2.5 GPA**

Minister Hunn Community Service and Leadership Scholarship

Demosthenes Hunn is a retired barber by vocation. He was a barber for over fifty years and was known to evangelize while he cut hair. Born August 26, 1931, he is 86 years young. Min. Hunn has dedicated his life to serving his church and young adults at the Fayette Regional Juvenile Detention Center. Every Sunday, Minister Hunn visits the Detention Center and teaches Bible Study lessons. His goal is to provide troubled youth with a more positive direction through God’s love and wisdom. Minister Hunn has also taught adult Bible Study classes at CBC. Several years ago, Pastor and Mrs. Gaines established this scholarship to recognize CBC students who are involved in community and church service.

The Minister Hunn Community Service and Leadership Scholarship

- **\$1,000 - one-time scholarship: Awarded in two \$500 installments (fall and spring semesters)**
- **High school seniors entering college**
- **Students who demonstrate service and leadership activities within the church and local communities**
- **3.0 GPA**

Book Scholarship

Deadline for submission:

One month after the first day of the fall or spring semester

Book Scholarship

- **\$200 per semester**
 - **maximum award of 8 semesters for undergraduate 4 year program**
 - **maximum award of 4 semesters for a two year academic or vocational program**
 - **2.5 GPA must be maintained to be eligible**
 - **Application must be made each semester**
