



How do I complete the on-line Registration for my child to attend the Consolidated Summer Enrichment Program?

1. Download the Church Center App from the Apple Store or Google Play
2. Click "Events" at the bottom of the device.
3. Click the Consolidated Summer Enrichment Program Flyer.
4. Click "Register" and follow the prompts.
5. After registration is complete an email will follow prompting you to submit your application and report card.
6. Go to "Groups" and join the group that you registered for.
7. Submit completed application and report card via email (Demetria.blair@consolidatedbaptist.org), postal mail or in person.

Can I Register, Apply and Pay in person?

Yes! Registration and Applications can be picked up and returned to Consolidated Baptist Church, 1625 Russell Cave Road, Lexington, KY 40505. Be sure to include the participant's report card with the packet to ensure there are no delays in processing.

Is there a Payment Plan?

Yes! Payments made through the Church Center App can be made in any amount of \$60 or more. Please note that once payments are started in the app, all future payments must be done through the app. The payment schedule is as follows:

\$35 Registration due: May 12

Payments due Schedule:

Attend June 10-July 3: \$345 payment due May 31

Attend July 8-Aug 2: \$345 payment due June 5

Attend June 10 - Aug 2: First payment of \$337.50 payment due: May 31, second payment of \$337.50 payment due: June 5

Can my child attend if he/she has not started Kindergarten?

All participants must have completed Kindergarten through fifth grade. As part of the application process, report cards must be attached in order to be considered "Enrolled."

What meals are provided?

Breakfast and lunch are available for those in the community no older than 18 years of age. Meals are nutritionally balanced according to FDA regulations. A light snack is also provided for program participants.

What if my child has an allergy? Can I Pack a Lunch?

It is imperative that all food allergies are made known. Where there is a documented diagnosis by a medical professional, families should pack their child's lunch. A weekly menu will be provided.

Is the camp open to the community? Is Transportation provided?

Yes, we are open to the community! Our program capacity is 100 students and can be attended by those enrolled in elementary school during the 2018-2019 academic year. Transportation is not provided to-and-from the Enrichment Program; however, we do provide transportation for our field trips.
